(open hand)

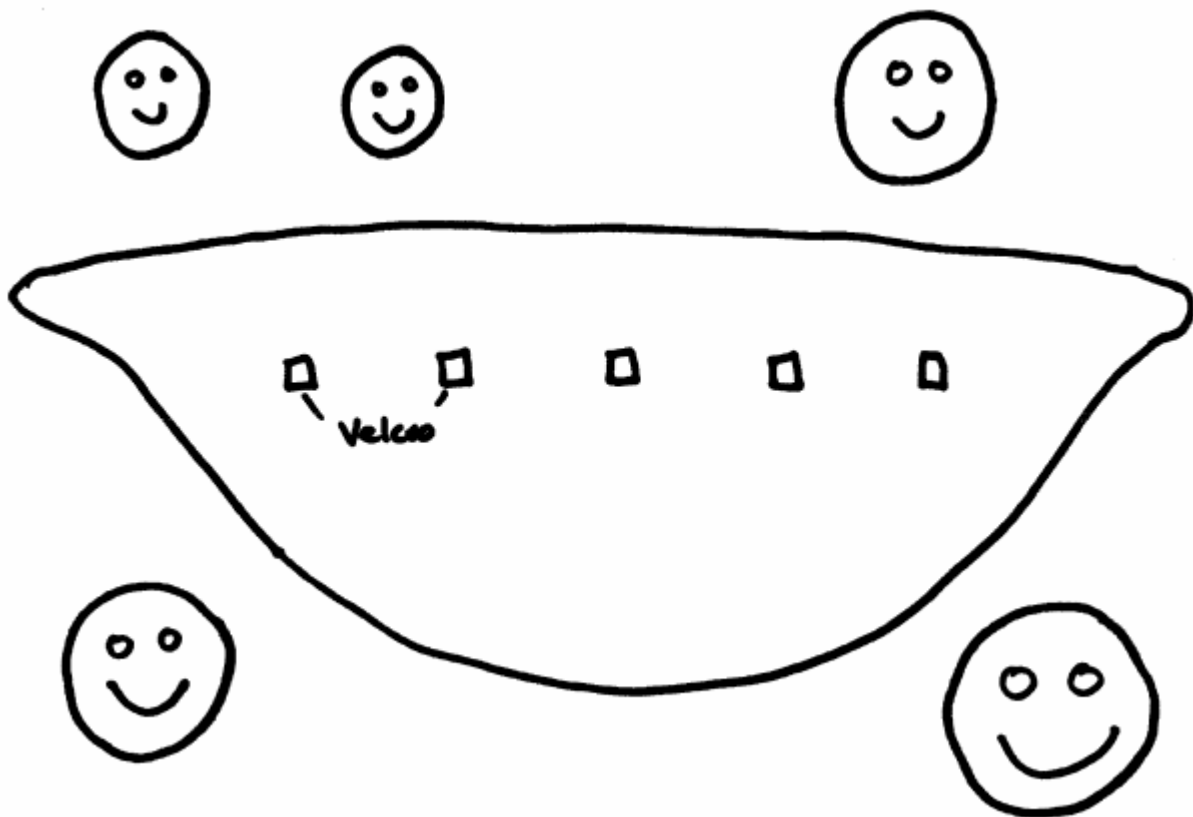


Make a "Peapod Family Home" (<http://macaronisoup.com/SongMay2005.htm>)

From green funfoam (so it can be used many times) or paper (won't last as long) cut 2 identical peapods - use the pattern below as a guide - yours should be about 10 - 12" wide. Attach 5 small velcro pieces across one side. Hot glue the bottom edge of the peapod pieces together.

Cut 5 green circles of various sizes, attaching velcro to the back of each. You can use wiggly/jiggly eyes or marker to make a face.

Your peapod is now ready - hide the peas inside, and let the child(ren) name them as they come out: Mama Pea, Daddy Pea, Sister Pea, Brother Pea, Baby Pea - or Grandpa/ma Pea, Babysitter Pea - whatever they choose! Attach peas to the outside of pod as they come out. When you're done with the fingerplay, store the peas back in the pod.
